SkyFuns Passanger briefing policy

Updated: march 06th 2026

Purpose

This policy establishes the minimum passenger briefing information expected before departure for shared flights listed on SkyFuns. Its objective is to promote transparency, passenger awareness, and safe operational practices.

Policy

1. Passenger Briefing

Before departure, pilots should brief passengers on key aspects of the flight, including:

- Planned route or general flight area
- Estimated flight duration
- Basic safety procedures and expected passenger conduct during the flight

2. Communication of Changes

Pilots should communicate any significant changes affecting the flight including weather conditions, operational considerations, or scheduling adjustments as early as reasonably possible.

3. Pilot-in-Command Authority

Passengers must understand that all operational and safety decisions remain under the authority of the Pilot in Command (PIC). The PIC has full discretion regarding the conduct of the flight.

4. Safety-Based Cancellation or Delay

The Pilot in Command may cancel, postpone, or modify the flight at any time if safety conditions are deemed unacceptable.

Responsibility

The Pilot in Command is solely responsible for:

- Flight safety
- Operational decision-making
- Compliance with applicable aviation regulations

SkyFuns assumes no operational control over flights listed on the platform.

Records

Pilots are encouraged to maintain a record confirming that the passenger briefing was completed. This may be documented either:

- In writing, or
- Through the SkyFuns platform where applicable.
